## THE CITY OF WESTPHALIA

ORDINANCE NO. 09-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REVISED RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE FACILITIES AND SERVICES MADE AVAILABLE BY THE SEWERAGE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF WESTPHALIA, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City that the present rates and charges for City sewer service fail to recover an amount reasonably necessary for the operation, maintenance, administration and improvement of the collection and treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City held a public hearing on June 30, 2009, after giving thirty days legal notice thereof, on the issue of revising such rates and charges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WESTPHALIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

## Section 1. Monthly Minimum Rates and Monthly Flat Rates for Sewer Service

From and after the first day of the month following the effective date of this ordinance, the minimum monthly rates and flat monthly rates required and which shall be charged and collected by the City of Westphalia, Missouri, for sewerage service furnished by the sanitary sewer system of said City shall be increased by 3%.

## Section 2. Monthly Usage Rate for Sewer Service

Plus, the monthly usage rate of \$1.70 per 1,000 gallons of water used per month shall also be increased by 3%.

## **Section 3.** Effective Date

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
